THE UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE ON THE LAW OF THE SEA

The United Nations Conference on the Law of the Sea was convened by the General Assembly of the United Nations in 1982. The Conference was held in Montego Bay, Jamaica, from 1982 to 1988. The Conference adopted the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS) on 10 December 1982. UNCLOS is a comprehensive treaty that defines the rights and responsibilities of nations in their use of the world's oceans and of related issues, including such issues as navigation, territorial waters, natural resources, etc. It is the primary legal instrument governing the world's oceans.

The Convention entered into force on 16 November 1994. It has been ratified by over 110 states. The Convention is widely regarded as the most comprehensive and balanced treaty on the law of the sea in history. It has been hailed as the 'Magna Carta of the Oceans'.
